FESTIVAL HUB Islesburgh Community Centre

The Festival Hub is the focal point of the Festival. A Weekend Pass entitles the holder to unlimited entry to the Hub from Thursday morning through to Sunday afternoon.

Pass holders who wish to attend Concert/ Dances in the Hub on Thursday and Friday evenings will also require a ticket for these events.

Pass Holders are entitled free entry to the Youth Concert on Saturday morning. A special 1 Day Pass is available for those who can only attend on Saturday.
